TUITION POLICY

- Parents have two payment options.
 - 1) Full payment of tuition – if paid in full by June 1, a \$200 (per student) discount is applied.
 - 2) Automatic monthly payment through the FACTS Management Company. Payments are made over a 12-month period beginning in June. FACTS will charge an annual processing fee per agreement.
- Tuition payments are non-refundable.
- When a child enrolls at FCS, a place is reserved for the entire school year. The school makes an annual commitment to provide school resources, so an annual commitment is required of the family. Once signed tuition contract is received, parents are obligated to pay tuition for the entire year.

Application Fee (Grades K4-12)

\$150 per student. This fee is non-refundable and due with each application.

Assessment Fee (Grades K5-8 Only)

\$85.00 per student. All students applying for grades Kindergarten through 8th grade will be required to complete an assessment. This fee is non-refundable and due with each application.

Financial Aid Applications

FCS awards need-based financial aid from current operating funds. Applications for financial aid can be accessed through our website.

Please note that this fee schedule is for the 2011-2012 school year. The 2012-2013 fee schedule will be released in January.

Non-refundable Deposit

Upon acceptance, the school requires a non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$750 per student to complete the enrollment process and reserve placement. It cannot be reclassified as a gift, refunded, or applied to another student. This deposit pays your \$250 registration fee and the remaining \$500 will be credited to the January tuition payment or one-time payment if paid in full.

Unpaid Tuition

We offer, through FACTS, two different payment dates (5th and 20th) for tuition payments. Tuition is considered late if you miss your scheduled withdrawal. Bank fees and late fees will be assessed according to bank and FACTS policy. If the account becomes delinquent, report cards will be held and the child may be withheld from class until arrangements are made. Parents whose tuition accounts are delinquent will not be able to re-enroll their children without satisfying their previous debts. Payments must then be kept current in order for their child to remain on a class list.
