RISING PRE-K

In order for your child to have a smooth transition, a few things are helpful to keep in mind as the start of the school year approaches. You may complete the attached certificate and return to your child's homeroom teacher during the first week of school to communicate that your child worked on the following skills during the summer.

INDEPENDENT SKILLS

- Work on being fully potty-trained and independent with bathroom needs.
- 2. Work on dressing yourself.
- 3. Playing with play dough or clay helps build fine motor skills in the hands.

FOLLOW ONE & TWO STEP DIRECTIONS

Work on following one and two-step directions at home in preparation for coming to school.

FOR 10 MINUTES

We will work on this in class as a whole group. Participating in activities that require your child to stay engaged for about 10 minutes will be great preparation for our classroom.

ENGAGE WITH OTHERS IN PLAY

Any opportunities you can provide for your child to engage with others in play will help prepare your child for school.

SEPARATE FROM PARENTS EASILY

Discussing the structure of the day and how your child will be dropped off in the morning and picked up at school will be helpful for your child as the start of school approaches.

LISTEN TO A BOOK BEING READ

Reading together is a great way to spend quality time with your child but also will help increase your child's vocabulary and also helps with holding attention for an extended period of time. This is a great way to prepare for our Pre-K Classroom.

VISIT THE LIBRARY

Visiting your public library to check out books that your child enjoys will help foster the love of reading.
