

# FCS ELEMENTARY 2019 SUMMER LEARNING ACTIVITIES

### RISING PRE-FIRST



Please choose 6 or more activities to complete with your child in preparation for Pre-First. When you have completed the activities, you may complete the attached certificated and turn it in to your child's homeroom teacher during the first week of school.

#### **ALPHABET BOOK**

Make an alphabet book. Write one letter on each page A-Z and draw a picture of something that begins with that letter and label the picture with at least one word or a sentence.

## SHAPES

Cut out at least 7 different shapes. (Square, triangle, circle, oval, rectangle, heart, diamond.)

#### **LETTER RECOGNITION**

Practice recognizing capital and lowercase letters.

#### **PLAY DOUGH**

Play with play dough and form the letters of your name. Then, make as many shapes as you can with the playdough.

#### **SOUNDS**

Review beginning, middle and ending sounds of words. Long/Short vowel review.

#### **READING**

Read or have someone read to you for 30 minutes.

# SPELL & WRITE YOUR NAME

Practice spelling and writing your first and last name. Write your full name 5 times.

#### **COUNTING MONEY**

Count 100 pennies. Take a handful of coins and sort them. Identify the coins and count dimes by 10.

#### **RHYMING WORDS**

Name 20 pairs of rhyming words.

#### **ROLL A NUMBER**

Get a pair of dice. Roll one and write the number. Roll the other and write that number. Add the two numbers together. Write and solve 10 problems.

#### **HANDWRITING**

Use lined paper, write all capital and lowercase letters in your best handwriting.

### **WORK A PUZZLE**

Work a puzzle with 30 pieces.

#### **RAZ KIDS**

Log on and read books using RAZ Kids. Take quizzes to help with fluency and comprehension.

#### **COUNTING TO 100**

See if you can count to 100 by 1's and 10's. Then, see if you can count backwards.

#### **CALENDAR**

Name the months of the year. Tell 5 people your birthday. Tell what day yesterday was, today is, and tomorrow will be.

#### **VACATION TRIP JOURNAL**

Draw a picture and write at least one sentence for each day on your vacation.

#### **SORTING**

Sort groups of small objects two different ways. (examples: buttons, coins, Legos, beads)

#### WORKBOOK

If you would prefer, you may purchase a rising kindergarten or first grade workbook and complete it in place of these activities. Summer Bridge or Vacation Station are two suggested options.
