RISING KINDERGARTEN



Please choose 6 or more activities to complete with your child in preparation for Kindergarten. It is highly recommended to complete the fine motor activities listed below. These fun activities will help your child prepare for the kindergarten classroom.

When you have completed the activities, you may complete the attached certificate and turn it in to your child's homeroom teacher during the first week of school.

ALPHABET BOOK

Make an alphabet book. Write one letter on each page A-Z and draw a picture of something that begins with that letter.

RHYMING WORDS

Name 20 pairs of rhyming words.

LETTER RECOGNITION

Practice recognizing capital and lowercase letters.

BEGINNING SOUNDS

Review beginning sounds of letters A-Z.

READING

Read or have someone read to you for 30 minutes each day. This helps build vocabulary.

SPELLING YOUR NAME

Practice spelling your first and last name.

COUNTING & SORTING COINS

Count 100 pennies.
Sort change: pennies, nickels, dimes & quarters

COUNTING TO 100

See if you can count to 100 by 1's and 10's.

CALENDAR

Name the months of the year. Tell 5 people your birthday. Tell what day yesterday was, today is and what tomorrow will be.

FINE MOTOR: WORK A PUZZLE

Work a puzzle with at least 25 pieces.

FINE MOTOR: PLAY DOUGH

Play with play dough & form the letters in your name.

FINE MOTOR: SHAPES

Cut out at least 5 different shapes.

WORKBOOK OPTION

If you would prefer, you may purchase a workbook for rising kindergarten and complete it in place of these activities. Summer Bridge or Vacation Station are two suggested options.
