Review beginning sounds of letters A-Z.

### **COUNTING & SORTING COINS**

Count 100 pennies. Sort change: pennies, nickels, dimes & quarters

### **FINE MOTOR: WORK A PUZZLE**

Work a puzzle with at least 25 pieces.

### **WORKBOOK OPTION**

If you would prefer, you may purchase a workbook for rising kindergarten and complete it in place of these activities. Summer Bridge or Vacation Station are two suggested options.

### **RHYMING WORDS**

Name 20 pairs of rhyming words.

### READING

Read or have someone read to you for 30 minutes each day. This helps build vocabulary.

### **COUNTING TO 100**

See if you can count to 100 by 1's and 10's.

### **FINE MOTOR: PLAY DOUGH**

Play with play dough & form the letters in your name

### LETTER RECOGNITION

Practice recognizing capital and lowercase letters

### **SPELLING YOUR NAME**

Practice spelling your first and last name.

### **CALENDAR**

Name the months of the year. Tell 5 people your birthday. Tell what day yesterday was, today is and what tomorrow will be.

### **FINE MOTOR: SHAPES**

Cut out at least 5 different shapes.
