

# Student Academic Support Levels

#### **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

The mission of the Student Academic Support (SAS) program is to provide students with the opportunity to maximize their learning abilities in order to reach their full academic potential.

FCS is a College Preparatory School that serves students with mild learning challenges.

FCS is not equipped to provide support for behavior challenges, significant accommodations or any modification that fundamentally alters the college preparatory program.

Each student is evaluated through the admissions process to determine the level of support needed to be academically successful within the FCS program.

The level of support is determined by the Student Academic Support team based on the documentation provided. Enrollment is considered a commitment for one school year.

## **Support Services**

On site academic therapy **not** provided by FCS or FCS employees. Students are not provided accommodations in any classes or standardized testing.

- -Provide both auditory and visual
- -Encourage self-advocacy skills (asking questions, making an appointment with a teacher)
- -Use of graphic organizers for writing assignments
- -Use a calendar or agenda (executive functioning)
- -Preferential Seating
- -No penalty for misspelled words or letter reversals unless specific to the assignment and student has been informed, may be asked to correct spelling errors but without penalty or prior to grading
- Allow use of technology for specific purpose (writing lengthy assignments)
- -Reduce the amount of copying material from the board when possib
- -Allow materials with fewer problems or questions on a page
